Schneck Medical Center is in constant pursuit of ways to provide excellent care. Since 1911, we have evolved from a 17-bed hospital to one of the most respected health institutions in the nation.

Today, Schneck is the only organization in Indiana to be honored with the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award, the nation's highest presidential honor for quality and performance excellence. Schneck was among only four U.S. hospitals recognized for their leadership and innovation in quality improvement and safety at the American Hospital Association Leadership Summit Awards and Recognition Program. And, Schneck received a Five Star Rating—the highest possible rating for quality of care, customer experience, and value of care received—from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services putting Schneck in the top 2.2 percent in the nation.

Schneck is among only seven percent of hospitals nationwide that have achieved Magnet® status from the American Nurses Credentialing Center. Of those, Schneck is among only two percent to achieve Magnet recognition three consecutive times.

Schneck's Cancer Center has been honored by the American College of Surgeons for excellence as the recipient of a commendation from the Commission on Cancer and the Outstanding Achievement Award for cancer care. Its Women's Imaging Center has been designated as a Breast Imaging Center of Excellence. And, its hip and knee replacement program has received The Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval for quality and safety and has been designated a Blue Distinction Center by Blue Cross Blue Shield.

Schneck has been named as one of Indiana's "Best Places to Work" and recognized nationally as a "Best Place to Work" in healthcare by The Advisory Board Company, *Becker's Hospital Review*, *Modern Healthcare* magazine, and *HealthExecNews*. It has also been ranked as the #1 Most Nurse-Friendly Hospital in the nation by *TopRNtoBSN* and Best Hospital Finance Department by *Healthcare Finance News*.
