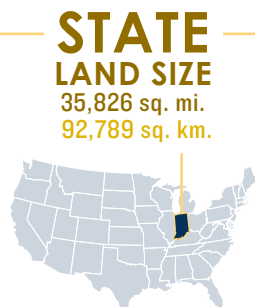

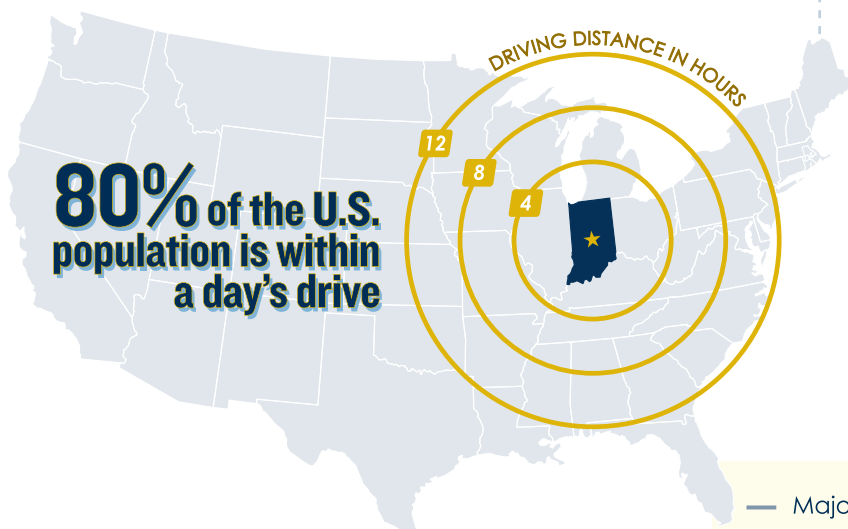

## TRANSPORTATION

### AIR

Indianapolis International Airport is the 8<sup>TH</sup> largest cargo airport and is home to the 2<sup>ND</sup> largest FedEx hub worldwide

### RAIL

1<sup>ST</sup> in the U.S. for rail tons of primary metal products originated and 3<sup>RD</sup> in the U.S. for total freight railroads

### ROAD

### WATER

With 3 international ports and 407 miles of navigable waterways, Indiana is home to the only statewide port system providing international connections for America's Heartland via the Great Lakes and Ohio-Mississippi river system.

### INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT

By the end of calendar year 2015, over \$11 billion will be invested in new infrastructure and preservation.
